Committee Reports:

- Worship: Pastor Jean reported that we have had a good turnout during Lent with more energy. A narrative lectionary will be used for the "the Littles" (very young children) matching the Spark Story Bible discussed the same day at worship.
- •Altar Guild: Everything is going good.
- •<u>Building & Grounds</u>: New paper towel holders is up in the men's bathroom. Church grounds need to be kept up with more by members. Maybe schedule a workday for volunteers to maintain the property. Also, the parsonage landscaping needs to come out and be redone with possible help from members. Church street sign needs replacing. This, and other topics, will be discussed at the Tri-church Council Board meeting on Tuesday, June 10 at 6p.m. at Peace Lutheran Church. All Board members from all three church will attend.
- The request by another church to purchase United's Handbells was unanimously voted down.
- Ruby's Pantry asked if we wanted to take the project on here at United was also voted down.
- Pastor Jean said she has met Julie Carlson, who is a SAM in our area. She is interested in being an part-time pastor. Next meeting date: Wednesday May 14, 2025


